# 3 LOCAL AUTHORITY FORUM 21 January 2021



The third Local Authority Forum (LAF) was attended by around 50 delegates from Scotland's Local Authorities.

This month, the forum welcomed representatives from the Scottish Government who gave a presentation and Q+A on the Climate Change Plan Update (CCPu).

LAF meetings will allow the SSN to work with members to outline how the CCPu aligns with and supports the Network's three strategic themes of NZ organisations, NZ indirect emissions, and NZ places.

The SSN Secretariat shared their initial plans on producing a 'Manual' which will support members as they work towards net zero targets.
