Q1. Do you agree with our outcome-based approach to adaptation in Scotland?

• Consider the advantages and disadvantages of an outcomes based approach

Q2. Do you agree that a National Forum on Adaptation should be established to facilitate discussion on climate change adaptation?

In developing your response you may wish to consider:

- The purpose of the Forum
- The influence and role of the Forum
- Who should / could represent your sector/ organisation on the Forum

Q3. Do you agree that climate change adaptation behaviours should be included in the Programme?

In developing your response you may wish to consider:

- Advantages and disadvantages of including adaptation behaviours
- Whether the adaptation behaviours included in the draft programme are appropriate
- If and how adaptation behaviours could be included more effectively

Q4. Do you agree that an integrated approach should be taken to monitoring and evaluation?

Consider:

- How will your organisation benefit from the proposed approach to monitoring and evaluation?
- Could the proposed approach to monitoring and evaluation be improved?

Q5. Do you agree with our long term vision for adapting to climate change in Scotland?

- What are the strengths and weaknesses of the vision?
- How could the vision be improved?

Q6. Does the Programme identify the right outcomes for Scotland over the next five years?

- Are there any outcomes missing?
- Could any of the outcomes be strengthened?

Q7. Are there any additional policies that should be included in the outcomes set out in the following pages?

Consider each outcome and the associated policies and proposals:

- Will the policies and proposals that have been included for each outcome result in measurable progress towards achieving the outcome?
- How could the policies and proposals be strengthened? Consider measurability and contribution towards achieving the specified outcome.
- Are additional policies and proposals required? What are the gaps? How could they be filled?
