**Sets clear goals** for long-term change and near-term milestones to evaluate success across Administrations


**Inspired 50+ cities** to publish resilience strategies that incorporate equity


Motivated global policy decisions in line with OneNYC (e.g. divestment from fossil fuels, IDNYC, Fight for 15)

New York City's long-term strategy to build a strong and fair city. The plan includes 8 goals and 30 initiatives to secure our city's future:



















### **NYC's Green New Deal**

OneNYC 2050 is NYC's Green New Deal for climate action and inclusive growth that will drive a reduction in greenhouse emissions and create green jobs. We will:



Achieve <u>carbon neutrality</u> and <u>100% clean</u> <u>electricity</u>

Require **buildings to cut their emissions** 

Ban new inefficient glass-walled buildings

<u>Hydro-power</u> City government

Mandate organics recycling citywide

<u>Reduce waste</u> and carbon-intensive consumption

OneNYC 2050 lays the foundation for **transformational change** by addressing climate as well as **social inequities.** Through this strategy, New York City will:



Introduce congestion pricing and improve bus service

Create **People Priority Zones** 

Guarantee health care for every New Yorker

End the **opioid epidemic** 

Expand the **IDNYC** municipal ID card

Support working New Yorkers

<u>Protect tenants</u> from displacement

Secure the City's **financial stability**

The City became a global leader by **mapping its strategy** with the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and demonstrating how it **will advance each goal**.








































### **A Livable Climate**

New York City will lead a just transition to achieve carbon neutrality and adapt the city to withstand and emerge stronger from the impacts of climate change.



# **Context: A Climate Emergency**

Our changing climate poses an **existential threat to our way of life** while the national government has abdicated leadership.



While New York City has made strides to achieve a reduction in emissions, **global emissions** continue to rise putting all New Yorkers at risk

Climate change is already having an impact on our **health**, our **livelihoods** and our **communities** 

A disproportionate burden has fallen on our city's most vulnerable populations and communities as we've seen with Hurricane Sandy

### **Progress Since OneNYC 2015**

New York City is **rising to the challenges**, and has become a global leader in the **fight against climate change**.


#### **A Livable Climate**

### **A Livable Climate Indicators**


OneNYC will **measure overall progress** towards achieving these goals using **indicators**. A few selected indicators are listed below:

INDICATOR	LATEST DATA	TARGET
Greenhouse gas emissions eliminated, reduced, or offset (compared with 2005 levels)	17% (2017)	100% (2050)
Air quality	7.85 μg/m³ particulate matter (2017)	Decrease
Share of electricity mix from clean sources	27% (2019)	100% (2040)
Premature mortality rate	189.4 deaths per 100,000 (2016)	25% reduction (2040)
Share of New York City trips by sustainable mode (walking, biking, mass transit)	68% (2017)	80% (2050)
