

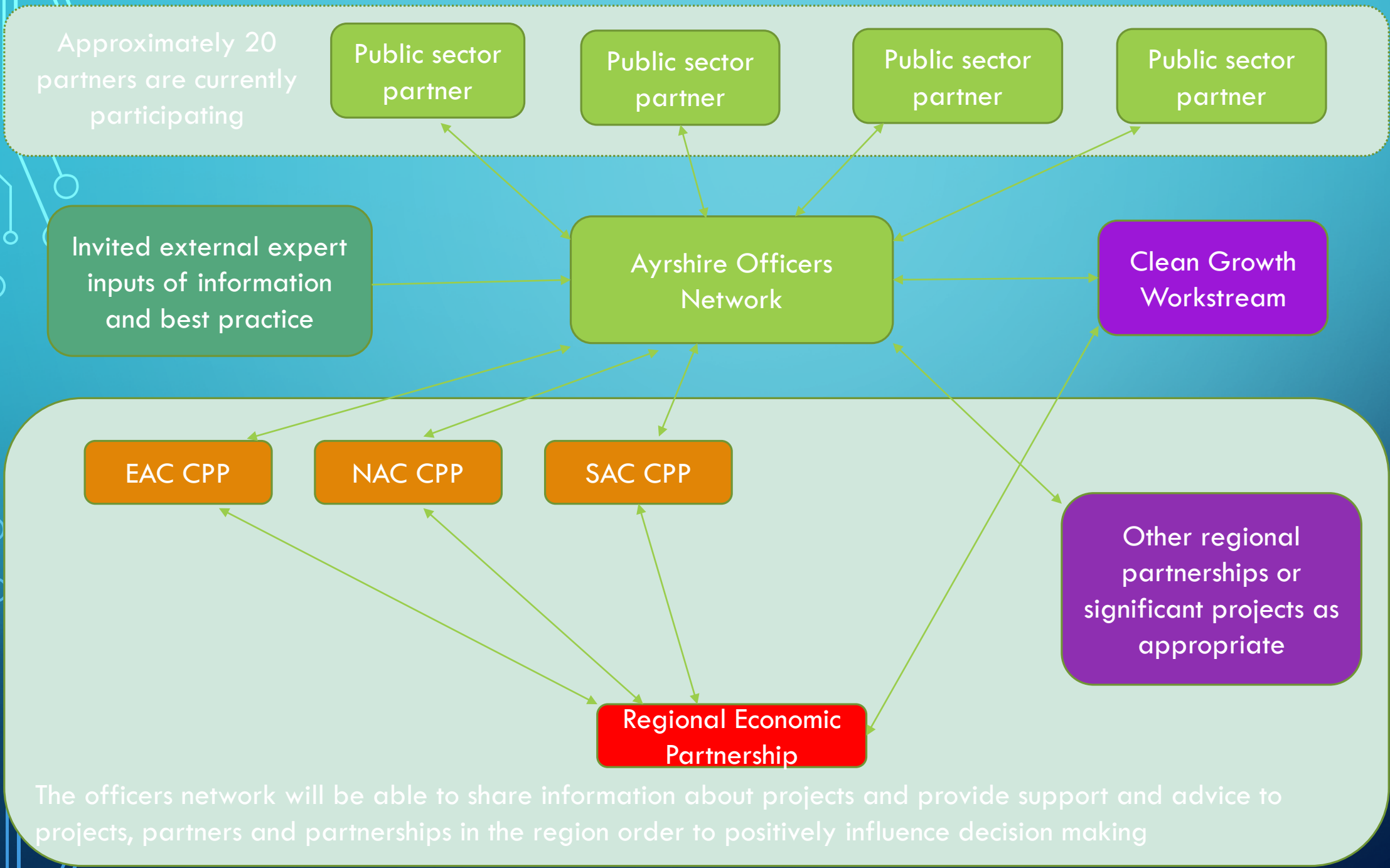


# AYRSHIRE'S REGIONAL APPROACH

## Vision

A prosperous and sustainable Ayrshire, where everyone can live well within environmental limits and be resilient to the impacts of change.

## Mission

Aligning and increasing regional collaboration to accelerate a green recovery that places Ayrshire on a clear path to net zero emissions by 2045 at the latest while supporting a resilient and just transition that tackles inequality and creates opportunities to improve well-being.

# BROAD TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Officers Network will meet at least 3 times a year, bringing together public sector partners and other key organisations in the Ayrshire Region.

The purpose of the network is to work to deliver the agreed vision and mission set out above.

The network will:

1. Connect the network through regular meetings and communications
2. Learn and share – from best practice and inspirational external inputs
3. Reflect on / monitor / measure regional progress (emissions, different tools etc)
4. Link beyond the network across our organisations and wider regional partnerships (our structure behind this work)
5. Be a source of support and seek to influence decisions which will impact on Ayrshire's ability to deliver net zero and be climate resilient.
6. Develop a project register to monitor key actions/interventions/projects and their impacts
7. report to the Ayrshire CPPs and Regional Economic Partnership

In do so the Officer Network will also assist the public sector bodies in the fulfilment of their own climate change duties.
